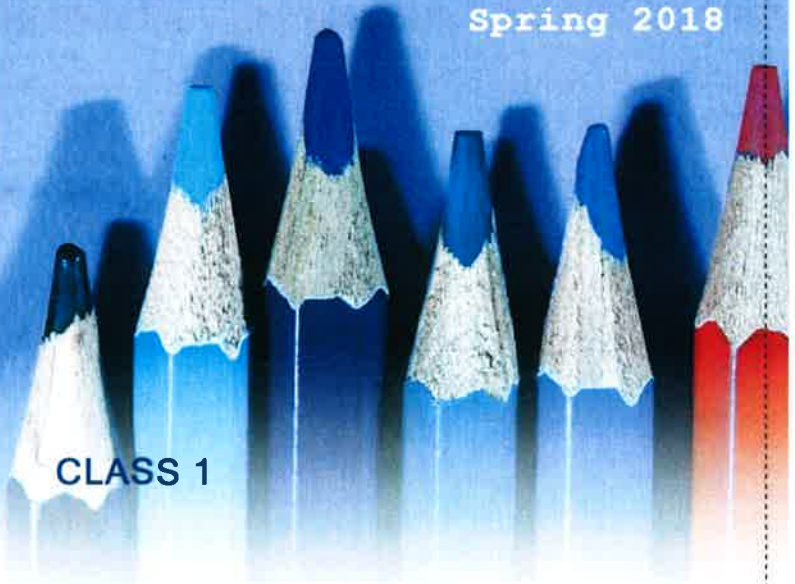

Literacy

Over the half term we will continue to use Read Write Inc for our phonics and we will explore our love of books through the "Power of Reading" texts.

Our outdoor learning will be linked to these stories and many of our favourite authors.

Reading focus- Join in with stories, rhymes and songs. Praise all emergent writing and move on to writing VC and CVC words along with learning our Common Words.

CLASS 1

Mathematics

In Mathematics this term we will be focusing on securing basic skills using White Rose Maths & Singapore maths (Maths no Problem). We will focus on place value, addition and subtraction and geometry and shape.

Science

We are continuing to look at Seasonal Changes this half term. This will include changes in weather and how the day length varies. As we move through the term we will compare and contrast the weather linked to Mathematics. As the Spring term develops we will look at Plants and New Life.

ICT

Laptops to build our keyboard skills.

Using iPads to further develop our learning in phonics, handwriting, mathematics and to provide a platform for research around our topic.

TOPIC: Our Favourite Authors

Art / DT

We will be learning and developing a range of skills through our topic such as: drawing skills, build and construct with a wide range of objects, selecting appropriate resources, and adapting their work where necessary. Select the tools and techniques they need to shape, assemble and join materials they are using. Handle tools, objects, construction and malleable materials safely and with increasing control. Explore colour, texture, shape, form and space in two or three dimensions. Express and communicate their ideas, thoughts and feelings by using a widening range of materials, suitable tools, imaginative and role play, movement, designing and making,

Input from local musicians. Learning songs based around our topic.

This term we will begin each session with a focus on team building skills. The remaining session will be based on activities around our favourite authors.
