English

In class 3 our literacy focus will be on Kenneth Graham's, 'Wind in the Willows'. We will be analysing the text and creating stories and other narratives based on this theme, as well as writing reports, explanations and diaries. We will perform a musical version for our Summer production. In addition, there will be regular spelling lessons with words to learn each week and regular punctuation and grammar lessons.

Maths

Over the next four weeks Year 6 will continue their preparation for Sats. The main focus will be on refining their problem solving skills. Year 5 will be working with Mrs Graham-Kevan for this period. They will be covering topics on translations, movements, reflections and measurement using the 'Maths-No Problem' scheme. In the second half of term Year 5 will focus on improving their arithmetic skills with Mr Livesey.

Topic

We will be making a local study of Coniston where we will be staying during our residential experience. This will include finding out about the village and lake and its literary and industrial heritage, collecting and using weather data, using and making maps, considering environmental concerns and thinking about habitats.
