Mr Livesey: As part of our Maths hub Mastery programme, Mr Livesey, has been given the opportunity to take part in a teacher exchange in Shanghai. This will enable him to experience teaching methods within China, deepening his knowledge and understanding of how we can empower children to be confident and fluent in aspects of maths. He will be travelling to China on Saturday morning and will be away for two weeks. During this period, I will be covering Class 3 for mornings and some afternoons, Miss Jackson will also teach some afternoons.
