Dear Parents,

100 Mile Challenge: Wednesday saw the launch of the 100 Mile Challenge. Every child is now challenged to complete as many miles as possible by walking, running, cycling or swimming – with the ultimate challenge being to complete one hundred miles by the end of the summer term. Every child has their own record card which should be kept at home and miles completed marked off and regularly shown to the class teacher who will transfer progress onto a class record sheet. Certificates will be awarded for 10, 25, 50, 75 miles as well as stickers along the way! The idea is to encourage a more active healthy lifestyle. Half term seemed like a great time to get started. It would also be great to post some photos of our children completing the challenge so please send in any photos you take along the way.
