
We are a Values school - This half term's value is: Generosity.

Severe weather and emergency closures: Can parents please note that if school needs to close early because of adverse weather conditions then we will contact all parents as soon as possible. No pupil will be allowed to leave the school until it has been established that their parents/carers are aware of the situation and have either collected their child or given permission for their child to either make their way home or leave with another parent. Additionally, should the school need to remain closed due to heavy snow or other extreme conditions, parents will be notified of the decision through the following means:

- Parent Hotline: A message will be placed on the parent hotline and can be accessed by all parents by telephoning 08447 70 75 76 and entering our school ID: 57370. The system can take several calls simultaneously, even at busy periods.
- By listening to local radio stations, namely Radio Cumbria, The Bay Radio and Lakeland Radio, who will announce school closures periodically throughout the day.
