Dear Parents,

Transition: Tomorrow and next Friday, all our classes will be spending the afternoon in their new class with their new teacher. Throughout the Challenge, library staff and teenage volunteers support the children, helping them to discover new authors and to explore a wide range of different types of books and ways of reading.

- Children sign up at their local library and receive **The Big Friendly Read** collector folder
- Children borrow and read at least six library books of their own choice during the summer, collecting special cards to complete their folder and rewards along the way
- Library staff and teenage volunteers are on hand to advise and run family-friendly activities
- Children who complete the **Summer Reading Challenge** are presented with a certificate and wristband.
