Severe weather and emergency closures: Can parents please note that if school needs to close early because of adverse weather conditions then we will contact all parents as soon as possible. No pupil will be allowed to leave the school until it has been established that their parents/carers are aware of the situation and have either collected their child or given permission for their child to either make their way home or leave with another parent. Additionally, should the school need to remain closed due to heavy snow or other extreme conditions, parents can keep up to date by listening to local radio stations, namely Radio Cumbria, The Bay Radio and Lakeland Radio, who will announce school closures periodically throughout the day.
